




Personal information protection


General EU protection policy

The policy on "protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data by the Community institutions" is based on Regulation (EC) No 45/2001 [en](#)  [235 KB] of the European Parliament and of the Council of 18 December. This general policy covers the European Union's family of institutional Web Sites, within the "eu.int" and "europa.eu" domains. The organization of the European Youth Event 2018 is based on the decision of the Bureau of the European Parliament on the European Youth Event 2018 under the reference leg PV BUR. 12.01.2015 [PE-8/BUR/PV/2015-01](#).

Although you can browse through most of these Web Sites without giving any information about yourself, in some cases, personal information is required in order to provide the e-services you request.

Web Sites that require such information treat it according to the policy described in the Regulation mentioned above and provide information about the use of your data in their specific privacy policy statements.

In this respect:

- For each specific e-service, a controller determines the purposes and means of the processing of personal data and ensures conformity of the specific e-service with the privacy policy;
- Within each Institution, a Data Protection Officer ensures that the provisions of the Regulation are applied and advises controllers on fulfilling their obligations (see Art. 24 of the Regulation);
- For all the Institutions, the European Data Protection Supervisor [en](#)  [27 KB] acts as an independent supervisory authority (see Art. 41 to 45 of the Regulation). The European Union's family of institutional Web Sites, within the "eu.int" and "europa.eu" domains, provides links to third party sites. Since we do not control them, we encourage you to review their privacy policies.
- The collection of data required for the participation in the European Youth Event 2018 organized by the European Parliament in June 2018 in Strasbourg, France, is provided by the contractor (Lyyti Linnankatu 13a A18, 20100 Turku, Finland and ProPager, 70 bld de Rueilly, 75012 Paris) and implemented by meeting all the security standards required by the European Parliament. The European Parliament is the owner of the data collected. All data will be treated according to the European Parliament's data protection policies. For the organizational purposes the necessary data can be provided to implementing agency.
- The online collection of ideas on the website [europeanyouthideas.eu](#) developed by Ecorys UK Ltd., 92-93 Edward St., Birmingham, United Kingdom. The European Parliament is the owner of the data collected.

Data Controller

The European Youth Event Unit (European Parliament, Rue Wiertz 60, 1047 Brussels, Belgium) being a data controller collects information during the registration process, including first and last name, country, region or state, street and number, town, post code, language, gender, birth date, phone number and email address.

This information is needed to organise the visit in an appropriate manner. The information on participants is collected from group leaders and participants and available to group leaders for modifications.

The personal details of group leaders and participants will be retained for until the end of June 2018. For groups which will receive the subsidies for travel/accommodation/meal, the details will be kept for audit purposes for the period of 5 years + 2 years possible discharge.

Participants will receive a confirmation message of their registration with details required to access the service. EP may also send information to announce important service changes, new features, information updates.

For the online ideas collection website the European Parliament collects the name/nickname, email address and the idea in form of a text. The authors of selected relevant ideas may be contacted by email by the European Parliament for further elaboration if consented by the author.

The European Parliament will not sell, lease or rent or otherwise transfer its member lists to any third parties outside the institution.

If you cancel your personal account with the European Youth Event, you will not receive any further mailings and you will not be able to participate in the event.

Security of your Personal Information
