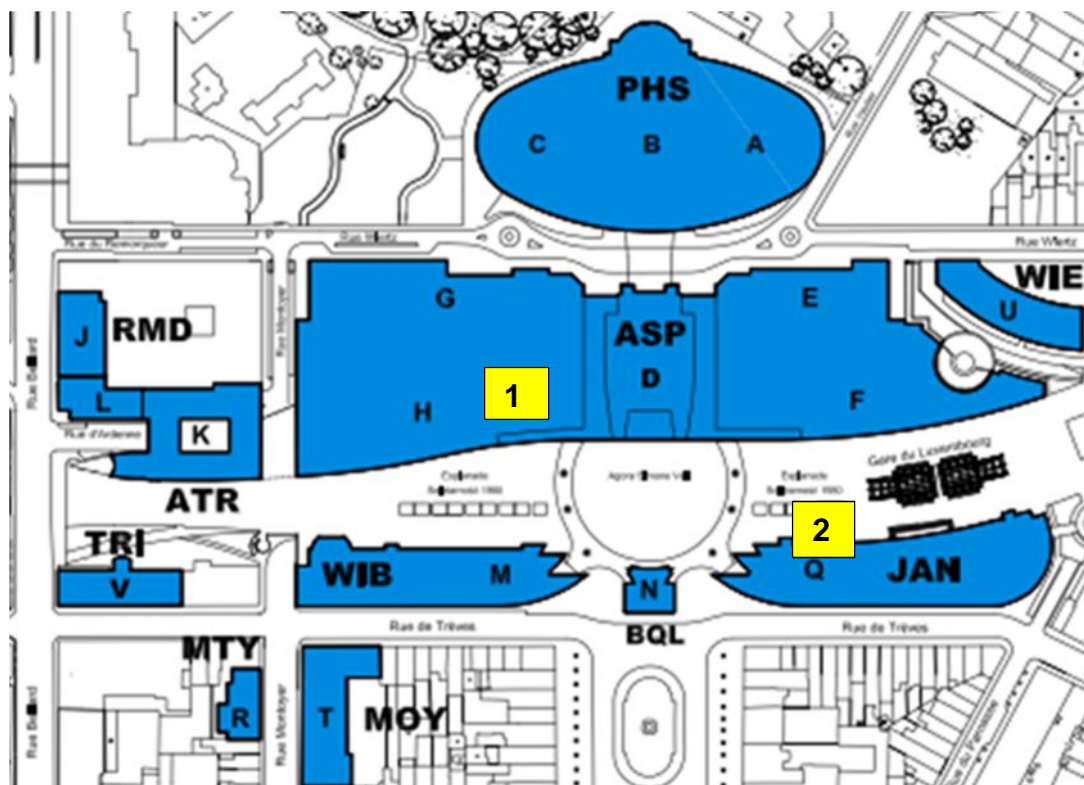

#### **ARRIVAL AND DISTRIBUTION OF ACCESS CARDS**

After the collection of the access cards for his/her delegation by a Brussels-based representative, the distribution to the delegation members is entirely his/her responsibility.

Once in possession of an access card, participants will enter via the entrance of the József Antall (JAN) building (marked with the number "2" in the map on the previous page) where the meeting room 4Q2 is located on the second floor. The way will be signposted.
