

Privacy Statement

Regulation 45/2001 (herein after "the Regulation") applies to the processing of personal data carried out by the European Parliament.

Further to Article 11 and Article 12 of this Regulation, the European Parliament provides the data subjects with the following information:

-) The controller is the European Parliament

-) Purpose of the processing:
Managing of Institutions, networks (ECPRD, IPEX, Representatives of national parliaments) and events for relations with national parliaments.
-) The categories of data collected and used for the processing operations are:
 - Name, birthdate, ID number, e-mail, telephone number, nationality, political affiliation, function; recruitment, contracts and career.
-) Data processing: Data is obtained directly by the data subject or through the Administration of the national parliaments. Could be automated, non-automated or manual, depending on the type of data.
Data has been processed since 1991.
Depending on the data, up-dating can be continuous, event-based or short-term.
-) The recipients of the data are:
 - EP services (Accreditation Unit, DG Safe, DG ITEC, Protocole, Financial services).Events information also available on Internet (eg. lists of participants: name and surname, name of parliament, function)
-) Data subjects: national parliaments Representatives, staff and Members of national parliaments. They have the right to access and rectify their data by contacting the person designated as being in charge of the processing operation.
-) The legal basis of the processing operation at stake is: EP Rules of Procedures, nos. 142 & 143.
-) The time limits for storing the data are the following:
 - Continuous up-dating (e.g. contact lists)
 - Event-based/Short-term (EP legislature)
-) The data subjects have the right to have recourse at any time to the Data Protection Officer of the European Parliament data-protection@ep.europa.eu and to the European Data Protection Supervisor edps@edps.europa.eu
