

ARRIVAL AND DISTRIBUTION OF ACCESS CARDS

After the collection of the access cards for his/her delegation by a Brussels-based representative, the distribution to the delegation members is entirely his/her responsibility.

Once in possession of an access card, participants will enter via the entrance of the Altiero Spinelli (ASP) building (marked with the number "2" in the map on the previous page) from where the meeting rooms (the hemicycle on Monday and PHS3C50 on Tuesday) are accessible.
