#### 1. <u>Chair's announcements</u>

#### The Contact Group

 <u>heard</u> Ms GUILLAUME, Vice-President, report that the two lead negotiators had been invited to the Conference of Presidents, on 27 September 2018, and to the Bureau, on 1 October 2018, to report on the state of play of negotiations, following the Commission decision of 18 July 2018 to mandate Mr TIMMERMANS, First Vice-President of the European Commission, to propose to suspend negotiations if the positions of Parliament and Council remained unchanged.

## 2. <u>State of play of the negotiations on the Commission proposal for a mandatory</u> <u>Transparency Register</u>

#### The Contact Group

- <u>heard</u> Ms GUILLAUME report that, in view of the Commission decision of 18 July 2018 and following the lead negotiators' recommendations by letter of 13 September 2018, the Conference of Presidents, at its meeting on 27 September 2018, underlined that the inter-institutional negotiations on an improved transparency register should continue, taking into account the progress that had been made;
- heard Ms GUILLAUME further report that the Conference of Presidents intended to

return to the matter at a subsequent meeting with a view to an endorsement of the lead negotiators' proposed two-fold approach, consisting of a recommendation that negotiations continue based on Parliament's mandate and that the measures that had been endorsed, in principle, by the Conference of Presidents on 27 June 2018, in the context of the negotiations, already be recommended to the Bureau for consideration with a view to implementation before the end of the parliamentary term;

- <u>heard</u> Ms HÜBNER, Chair of the Committee on Constitutional Affairs (AFCO), note that that approach would underline Parliament's commitment to transparency as the EU institution representing citizens directly at Union level;
- <u>heard</u> Ms HÜBNER report on the postponement of the vote in AFCO on the report on amendments to Parliament's Rules of Procedure, as additional time had been requested to consider amendments relating to meetings of rapporteurs, shadow rapporteurs and committee chairs with interest representatives;
- heard Mr GIEGOLD enquire about the Bureau meeting on 1 October 2018;
- <u>heard</u> Ms GUILAUME and Ms HÜBNER underline the importance of a proper sequencing of decisions by Parliament's governing bodies, noting that, following an endorsement of the two-fold approach by the Conference of Presidents, the Bureau could already commence the consideration of the implementation of specific measures, particularly in view of the limited time remaining until the end of the parliamentary term;
- <u>held</u> an exchange of views with the participation of Mr WIELAND, EPP Group, Mr LEINEN, S&D Group, Ms RUOHONEN-LERNER, ECR Group, Ms PAGAZAURTUNDUA RUIZ, ALDE Group, Mr GIEGOLD, Greens/EFA Group, Mr DE JONG, GUE/NGL Group, and Ms ADINOLFI, EFDD Group, during which broad support for the approach of the lead negotiators was expressed, and which focussed, inter alia, on:
  - ) the legal scope of Members' independent mandate;
  - ) the approach chosen for the Code of Appropriate Behaviour for Members and the declaration relating to that code;
  - ) the AFCO report on amendments to Parliament's Rules of Procedure;
  - ) the culture of transparency in the EU institutions;
- <u>heard</u> Ms GUILLAUME and Ms HÜBNER thank Members for their support and conclude that they would present the two-fold approach to the Conference of Presidents, and that considerations in AFCO were a parallel process that should not hinder the inter-institutional negotiations from continuing based on the adopted mandate;
- <u>endorsed</u> the lead negotiators' approach.
