

Clarification

Dear Mr. Adam,

Last sentence of Article 7 of our statutes reads: “De même, toute institution publique peut contribuer par des subventions”


This sentence should be interpreted according to the following principles:

1 – Regulation 1141/2014, its article 20 and every other provisions concerning funding supersede statutory provisions of Centre Maurits Coppieters.

2 - Centre Maurits Coppieters shall not accept donations from any public authority from a Member State or a third country, or from any undertaking over which such a public authority may exercise, directly or indirectly, a dominant influence by virtue of its ownership of it, its financial participation therein, or the rules which govern it.

3 – Centre Maurits Coppieters shall not accept donations from any private entities based in a third country or from individuals from a third country who are not entitled to vote in elections to the European Parliament.

4 – Centre Maurits Coppieters abide by applicable legislation concerning donations and contributions.
